Sailing Camp Scholarship Information

Lighthouse Charities, Inc., a subsidiary of the Oklahoma City Boat Club (OCBC), is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization that connects OCBC and sailing with the greater Oklahoma City community. Youth Sailing, the most developed of the Lighthouse community sailing programs, now has limited scholarship funds to help subsidize the costs of youth sailing programs and activities for youth who might otherwise not be able toparticipate in the sport of sailing.

A Sailing Camp Scholarship covers the entire camp fee for a single one-week session of camp. Youth are generally limited to one scholarships per summer. Children of OCBC members are not eligible to receive scholarships.

Eligibility

Youth must meet the following criteria to qualify for a Sailing Camp Scholarship:

- 1. Eligibleto attend Sailing Camp (see Essential Eligibility Requirements for Sailing Camp)
- 2. Youth or family qualifies for, or receives assistance from, one or more of the following programs:
 - ☐ Free or Reduced-Price School Meal Program
 - ☐ Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
 - ☐ Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - ☐ Foster Care (Child Welfare Services)
 - ☐ Medicaid Health Insurance (SoonerCare)
 - □ Unemployment Benefits
- 3. Brief essay written by youth describing why he/she would like to attend Sailing Camp

The Sailing Camp Scholarship ApplicationIncludes three separate parts:

- 1. Youth's essay about interest in sailing
- 2. Sailing Camp Scholarship Application form, completed and signed
- 3. One document demonstrating financial need

<u>Applications are accepted</u> on an ongoing basis. Please submit the scholarship application, in place of the deposit fee, with your child's Sailing Camp Registration Packet.

<u>Scholarships are awarded</u> on a first come, first served basis. We will award scholarships throughout the summer until the Youth Sailing Scholarship funds are depleted.

Confidentiality

The Youth Committee keeps all scholarship applications and the names of individual Sailing Camp Scholarship recipients confidential. If we use your child's essay for Youth Sailing Scholarship information or publicity purposes, all identifying content will be redacted in advance.
